Clock on for photo of your race finish

EVERY runner and walker in tomorrow's *Sunday Mail* City-Bay Fun Run is guaranteed a photo-finish.

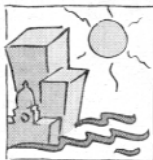
A camera mounted behind the Colley Reserve finishing post will capture each participant's moment of glory, with nearly 12,000 frames to be taken.

Sports In Focus managing director Michael Selfe expects a frame to be taken every half second.

Participants can search for their photo online at www.adelaidenow.com.au from Monday. To find their photo, participants must enter the time which appears on the main clock when they cross the line.

They should not enter their race time (for example, 75 minutes). The

photographs, presented in a commemorative border, cost \$20.

French company DAG Systems provides the electronic timing system and technician Xavier Michel has travelled from France to make sure it runs smoothly on race day.

"To be able to search for a picture using the time as a very specific guide is great," he said.

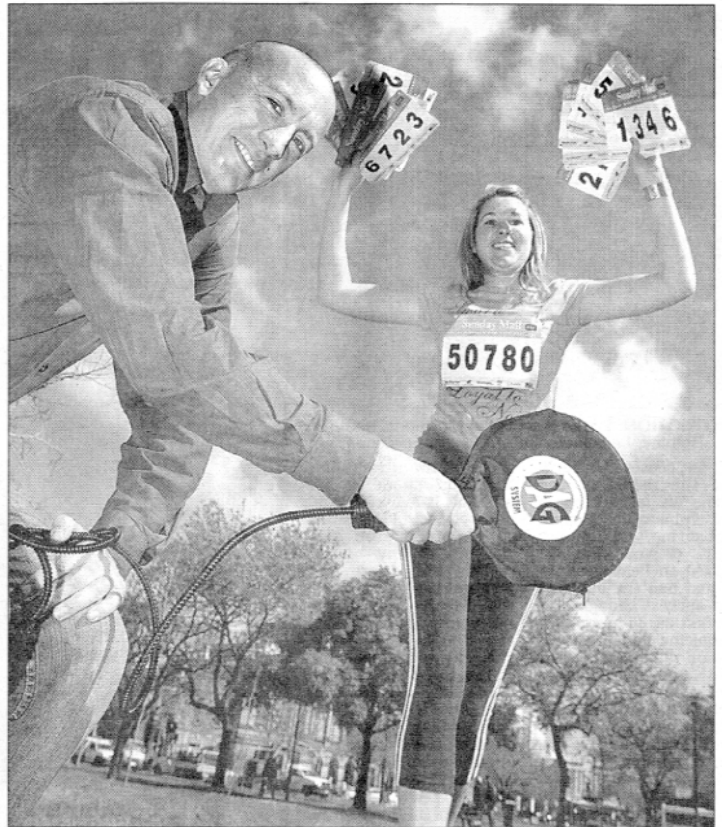
Four live webcams pro-

vided by Adam Internet will stream footage live from various points on the route. Participants can download one minute of footage from any of the cameras on AdelaideNow from Monday. Again, they must use clock times.

Race director Joe Stevens said that if you have registered for the event but have not received your registration pack, you should call 8232 6184.

Packs need to be collected from the office at 73 Wakefield St before noon today.

City-Bay competitors are warned not to be fooled by showery weather tomorrow morning. A high of 20C is forecast, so all runners should make sure they are well hydrated.
